- Appoint a competent club member to assist with health and safety responsibilities.
- Ensure that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place and known by all members.
- Provide access to adequate first aid facilities.
- Each playing section must conform to the health and safety requirements of the governing sports body (ECB & BE)
- Accidents, incidents and near misses occurring must be documented in the accident book including the actions undertaken by Club personnel. This book will be kept in the clubhouse, viewed by the Committee to consider if any risk management strategies required.
- Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

AS A CLUB MEMBER YOU HAVE A DUTY TO:

- Take reasonable care for your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do.
- Co-operate with the club on health and safety issues.
- Report all accidents, incidents and near misses.
- Report any hazard that could lead to accidents or injuries.
- Correctly use all equipment provided by the club.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
